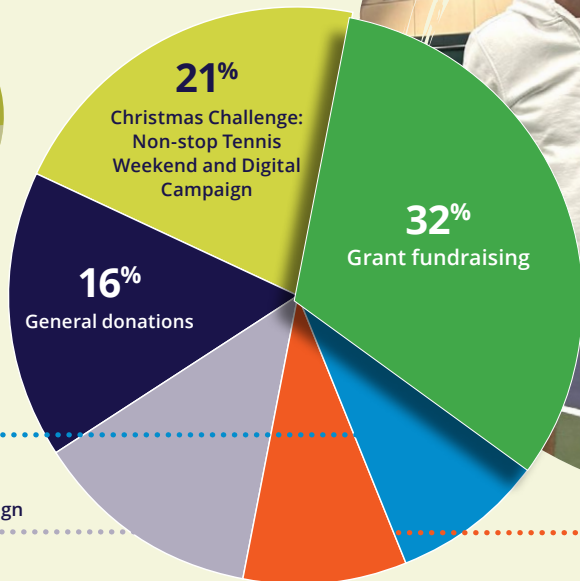
Our impact 2023-2024

We delivered 55 Sport & Education programmes reaching 5,080 young people, and provided 17 grants reaching a further 6,236 youngsters as well as 12 additional projects.

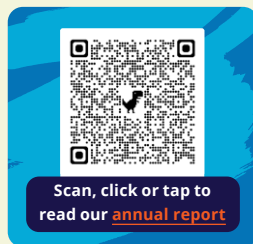

Education Programmes

Scholarships

-  Four scholarships were given for young people from single or no parent households to attend Reed's School.
-  It costs 1.82 times more to put a child through the care system than it does to fund them at a top boarding school with wrap-around and holistic care.
-  Two students have gone on to attend university in the last two years.

Opportunity Fund

-  Regular tuition in core subjects was provided for 1,074 children who require additional support to help increase their attainment.
-  The attainment gap has widened considerably since Covid.
-  99% of students improve their grades with extra tuition.

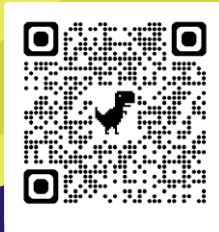

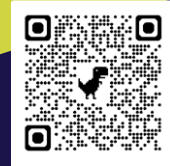
